

Operating Grants: Use existing guidelines

- Determine the allocation of funds by percentage for operating grants and Thrive.
- 2. Adopt existing grant guidelines and criteria with no changes.
- For the funding formula, award funds in alignment with the base percentage for funding categories, scaled to the amount allocated to operating grants.


Decide the allocation of funds by percentage for operating grants and Thrive.

Justification:


- Scalability: Percentages automatically adjust as the total amount changes. The proposed funding formula model utilizes a scaled approach.
- Future planning: When using percentages, allocations can be planned before knowing the final budget
- Communication and transparency: Percentages often communicate proportional relationships more intuitively than raw numbers.

FY24 Funding Allocation




70-30 Allocation Model

Adopt existing grant guidelines and criteria with limited changes.

Justification:

- Community engagement: Guidelines have already gone through extensive community engagement processes.
 Current applicants: These were the posted guidelines when applicants applied in January 2023.
- Equity: Advances equitable funding models.

Adopt existing grant guidelines and criteria with limited changes.

Changes to guidelines with reasoning:

- Change dates and deadlines
 - To reflect abbreviated timeline
- No mid-point review necessary
 - Because of abbreviated timeline
- Applicants can revise current application
 - Because of time lapse between application and award (>1 year)
- No additional funds for higher scores (93-100)
 - Because of limited budget

For the funding formula, award funds in alignment with the base percentage for funding categories, scaled to the amount allocated to operating grants.

Justification:

Scaling the award based on available funds honors the values and integrity of the original funding formula, ensures that all applicants who score at a high level receive funding, and is resonant with the application (which has always stated that actual funding is predicated on available budget).





If the allocation is 50% for Operating, each applicant who scores 70-100% would receive a minimum of 26.59% of their request

If the allocation is 60% for Operating, each applicant who scores 70-100% would receive a minimum of 31.91% of their request




If the allocation is 70% for Operating, each applicant who scores 70-100% would receive a minimum of 37.22% of their request


How could orgs receive more than the minimum?

This proposal reflects the award amount if 100% of the orgs who apply score in the 70-100 range and are therefore funded at the maximum amount.

If fewer orgs score in the 70-100 range and therefore fewer are funded, the amount awarded per org will increase incrementally.




